Please pass along the following scholarship application to the parents of eligible children that are interested in participating in the competition. We look forward to receiving the applications for our 2023 Home Builders Association Scholarship Program.

To qualify, the applicant must:

- a. be the **child or grandchild** (by blood, marriage, or adoption) of an *owner or employee* of a company that is a **current member** in good standing of the **Home Building Association of Central Virginia.**
- b. a high school senior OR undergraduate college student.
- c. Annual scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis to students who demonstrate a commitment to academics, leadership capabilities and an entrepreneurial spirit. Financial need is also a consideration. Qualified applicants must be graduating seniors of a public or private high school in the city of Lynchburg or the counties of Amherst, Appomattox, Bedford and Campbell County and plan to attend an accredited 2-year or 4-year community college, college or trade school in the United States.

The application deadline for the 2023 Scholarship is Friday May 19th, 2023. Applications must be received in the HBACV office no later than 5:30 pm on May 19, 2023.
